

HOUSEHOLD TOXINS

CATS:

1. Tylenol (Acetaminophen)
2. Pepto-Bismol
3. Imodium
4. Aspirin
5. Ibuprofen
6. Plants: Easter Lilly, Peace Lilly, Poinsettia, etc.
7. Onions: be careful some canned baby food contain onion powder
8. Rat Poisons
9. Lead: fishing weights, old paint chips, BB's, batteries
10. Zinc: pennies can cause obstructions and zinc toxicity
11. Antifreeze (Ethylene glycol)
12. Any prescription drug not intended for that pet is potentially toxic
13. Illegal drugs: marijuana, alcohol, cocaine, narcotics (even tobacco)

DOGS:

1. Chocolate: especially dark and Baker's chocolate
2. Antifreeze (Ethylene glycol)
3. Rat Poisons
4. Lead: fishing weights, old paint chips, BB's, batteries
5. Zinc: pennies can cause obstructions and zinc toxicity
6. Ibuprofen
7. Tylenol (Acetaminophen)
8. Aleve
9. Any prescription drug not intended for that pet is potentially toxic
10. Illegal drugs: marijuana, alcohol, cocaine, narcotics (even tobacco)

It is very important for you to remember to bring the bottle/box of whatever your pet has consumed to the veterinarian in order to treat your animal as quickly as possible.
